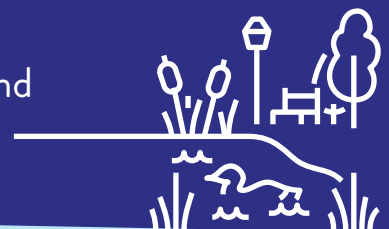
This chapter discusses how Canada's cities and towns are impacted by climate change, and how they are moving from adaptation planning to action.
